## AFFIDAVIT OF SARAH BEATTIE

I, Sarah Beattie, being first duly sworn upon my oath, depose and state as follows:

1. My name is Sarah Beattie and I am an adult over the age of 18. I am a resident of the State of Arizona, County of Maricopa. Everything I will testify to in this affidavit is based upon my personal knowledge, unless I set forth that the matter is based upon my information and belief.
2. Throughout my adult life I have been involved in political elections. It is work that I have been very successful with. However, I fully expect that by coming forward and telling what I know about the misconduct in the Office of the Attorney General that I will be the subject of a smear campaign by members of the Attorney General's staff. I know that the efforts of these people to smear my good name may well damage my reputation in the political community, and that finding future work in this field may be difficult, but I believe it is important to step forward and let the citizens of Arizona know what I know.
3. In the summer of 2013 I was a roommate with Brett Mecum. I considered Mr. Mecum a close friend, but we were not involved in any romantic relationship. I was aware that Mr. Mecum was employed as the Legislative Liaison for the Office of the Attorney General. Mr. Mecum was aware of my successful track record as a political fundraiser. I had been involved in the following campaigns fundraising: McCain 2010, Flake 2012, Quayle 2012, Montgomery 2012, and the Republican House Victory Committee 2012.
4. Mr. Mecum and I often discussed politics. Mr. Mecum was aware that in the summer of 2013 I was in need of a job. Sometime prior to August 1, 2013, Mr. Mecum recruited me to come to work with him in the Arizona Attorney General's Office. Mr. Mecum told me that Kathleen Winn's assistant was moving to a different department and that I could "slot into" that

position. I did not know much about the official job. I met Kathleen Winn and Brett Mecum for lunch one day to discuss the job. The focus of this luncheon was all about Tom Horne's re-election campaign, and how Tom Horne, Kathleen Winn and Brett Mecum were "victimized" by the local press. They both explained to me how much help they needed on Tom Horne's reelection campaign for 2014. I do not recall learning much about the actual position and what was expected of me. I was very upfront with Ms. Winn and Mr. Mecum, even to the point of making sure they were aware of my DUI. In fact, when I sent my resume to Ms. Winn I asked that she be sure to make the HR department aware of my DUI. See email dated July 24, 2013, attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**.

5. Shortly after that meeting, the position that I had spoken to Kathleen Winn and Brett Mecum about, was posted on the Arizona Attorney General's website. Kathleen Winn told me that I had to go through the normal interview process, but that it would be pretty much a formality. I met with Kathleen Winn, who was the Director of Community Outreach in the Office of the Arizona Attorney General for my formal interview. During that conversation Ms. Winn again told me that the Tom Horne 2014 campaign would need my help.

6. On August 1, 2013, I was hired by the Office of the Arizona Attorney General as an Administrative Assistant III, within the Executive Office Division/Community Outreach Section. My base salary was \$32,000. See **Exhibit 2**, attached. Kathleen Winn was the Director of that Section, and therefore, my boss.

7. I found it very difficult to work for Ms. Winn. Early on I realized she wanted me to do campaign work *while working during official State hours*. This was not what I expected when Ms. Winn and Brett Mecum told me they needed help on Tom Horne's reelection campaign. For example, I was asked to work on a statement of Tom Horne's "17 Major Achievements"

while in office. See email dated August 13, 2013, attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**. I was told in the email by Ms. Winn that it was a “top priority” and it was needed “stat.” I received this email around 2:15 p.m. while I was at work. Anyone reviewing these records will see that for the most part, they are from private email accounts, even though they are sent during regular working hours. Ms. Winn made it very clear from the onset that any campaign related communications were to be sent only on private email accounts and private laptops, and not on the Attorney General’s email account. What Ms. Winn did not ever state or stress, is that we should not be sending such emails while at work on official State time. During the approximate month and one half that I worked with Ms. Winn I received other similar campaign communications during regular working hours. See for example, the attached email to me dated August 16, 2013, regarding Tom Horne’s “achievements” list where she let me know she thought I was moving slow by telling me “no kidding on this.” This was sent to me at 1:05 p.m. while I was on normal working hours. See email dated August 16, 2013, attached as **Exhibit 4**. It made me feel very uncomfortable that Ms. Winn was pressuring me to work on Tom Horne’s campaign during normal working hours. Because of my prior work on other election campaigns for other politicians who were campaigning for reelection, I was keenly aware of the importance of not doing campaign work while on the taxpayer dime. I later learned that this was also in violation of a memo prepared by the Office of the Solicitor General. See Solicitor General’s Office Memorandum dated September 5, 2013, and attached hereto as **Exhibit 5**.

8. Approximately, one and a half months into my hire I decided to quit working under Ms. Winn to fundraise for one of the Republican campaigns that was just getting started. There was a narrow window of opportunity at that time to join up with a campaign and if I did not take it, the opportunity would be lost.

9. I went to Tom Horne's office to let him know I would be leaving. In addition to me and Tom Horne, Art Harding was also present at that meeting in Mr. Horne's office. I told Tom Horne that I didn't like working with Kathleen Winn. I told him that it made more sense for me to be in Constituency Services and if he would agree to move me it would get me out from having to work with Ms. Winn. I specifically told Tom Horne "I think she is a hazard to your campaign." I told Tom Horne and Art Harding that on more than one occasion in the Executive Office and to more than just me, Ms. Winn would say "Tom Horne will never get rid of me; I know where all the bodies are buried." I explained to Mr. Horne that if he could not move me to Constituency Services, it would be okay. I explained that it was election campaign season and that I was getting a lot of job offers to go do fundraising and that if I was going to do it, I would have to do it right then. Tom Horne responded "We need you through next November. Okay, I will talk to Human Resources." I told Mr. Horne that I could go and make a base pay plus commissions doing fundraising well above what I was being paid to work in the Attorney General's Office. Mr. Horne responded "Okay, I'll take care of it."

10. On September 23, 2013, I was moved to Constituent Services in the Executive Office and given a raise to \$35,000 per year. See **Exhibit 6** attached. When I realized the pay raise was not consistent with what Mr. Horne led me to believe I would receive I went back and talked to him again. On October 25, 2013, I was notified that my new annual salary would be \$45,000. See **Exhibit 7** attached. I would state that on the average I spent 2 hours a day on Constituency Services, and the rest of the time was spent doing campaign work for Tom Horne's reelection. A review of my official computer browser history for my Executive Office computer and my "azag.gov" official email account will provide support for this statement.

## TOM HORNE

11. I was not alone in the Executive Office doing campaign work on government time. Between August 1, 2013, and the date of my resignation of April 22, 2014, the majority of people employed in the Executive Office of the Arizona Attorney General's Office were campaigning for Tom Horne during regular business hours. This included Tom Horne himself. By way of example, Tom Horne kept a white three ring binder on his shelf behind his desk. The spine of this white binder was deliberately mislabeled "BORDER PATROL." The contents of the binder had nothing to do with the Border Patrol. Instead, the binder contained a substantial list of donors from the 2010 campaign and the 2014 campaign with Tom Horne's handwritten notes from calls that he made to donors. The contents of this binder were solely dedicated to campaign fundraising and solicitation. I have seen Mr. Horne use the binder marked "BORDER PATROL" *daily* to make campaign solicitation calls in his office. In those instances, Mr. Horne was careful to use his private cell phone, but the calls were still made from his official office. I can specifically recall that Mr. Horne solicited donations from Ira Gaines and Donald Tapia while in his official office. I also recall being present when Mr. Horne solicited campaign money in his official office from a woman named "Layla" who was actually a Democrat from Paradise Valley. Tom Horne told me she was "Persian" and that her "husband had been indicted." When planning the invite for the fundraiser, Mr. Horne told me not to use her full name because of her husband's indictment. I will state that there were times I did see Mr. Horne make fundraising calls while not in his official office, but that does not change the fact that a substantial amount of solicitation calls were made by Tom Horne inside the Executive Office.

12. I recall a time that Tom Horne, Brett Mecum, Garrett Archer and I were in Garrett Archer's office discussing where would be the best place to host a fundraiser for Tom Horne's

reelection campaign with Ken Cuccinelli as the headliner. Tom Horne reviewed a list of possible donors that I had. Tom, Brett and I made several phone calls to possible donors as hosts. Finally Tom Horne decided that Donald Tapia's residence would be the best place to host the event, and Tom Horne placed the call from Garrett's office to Mr. Tapia, who then agreed to host the event. After Mr. Tapia agreed to host the event, Brett, Garrett and I prepared the fundraiser flyer and it was sent to most of the members of the Executive Office for review and edit. This was all done during working hours.

13. Tom Horne consistently gave my official office number to people for fundraising events. Multiple times I asked Tom Horne not to give out my office number for fundraising or campaign related purposes. I got so frustrated with him that I sent out an email to members of the Executive Staff to ask them not to give out my official office phone number during campaign events and included Tom Horne on it. See email dated March 6, 2014, and attached hereto as **Exhibit 8**. Although I sent the email to everyone, it was really meant specifically for Tom Horne who kept giving out my number to people for fundraising purposes.

14. About three months ago, someone from the Executive Office sent out a campaign email and used my official [sarah.beattie@azag.gov](mailto:sarah.beattie@azag.gov) email address. I replied all and told everyone, including Tom Horne, to delete my office email address from the email chain. Tom Horne hit "reply all" without deleting my official email address. I don't recall if I hit "reply all" or just emailed at least Tom Horne, but again I asked for my official email address to be deleted from the chain. Tom Horne came to my desk and apologized "I really messed up, didn't I?" Tom Horne then instructed me to delete the email and then stood over my shoulder to ensure that I had deleted it. I did delete the email however it should still be available on the server. I knew that

was not right and I voiced my frustrations to other members of the Executive Office staff about being pressured to delete the email.

14. On or about October 15, 2013, I was asked by Tom Horne to meet him at Molina's Fine Jewelry store at 32<sup>nd</sup> Street and Camelback in Phoenix. The purpose of this meeting was to evaluate Molina's as a possible place for a fundraiser from Tom Horne's reelection campaign. I left work in my own car and traveled to Molina's. Tom Horne and Carmen Chenal also went to Molina's. While Tom, Carmen and I were at Molina's the owner had me try on a ring that I was told was valued at \$8,000,000. Tom Horne suggested that Carmen Chenal try on the same ring. When Ms. Chenal did, Tom Horne asked me to take pictures of Ms. Chenal's hand with the ring on it. A copy of those pictures and the relevant metadata are attached to this affidavit as **Exhibit 9**. The metadata is important not just because it shows the GPS positioning and the date, but also the time which shows that I took the pictures was just shortly after noon. This is important because it reflects that we had to leave the Executive Office of the Attorney General before lunchtime to make the visit at Molina's for a campaign purpose.

15. Tom Horne routinely walked around and pulled members of the Executive staff into meetings regarding the Brnovich and Rotellini campaigns. These meetings were done during regular office hours and not on our lunch hours or breaks. Additionally, there were Calendar meetings which were intended to review and work on the Attorney General's official business. But these meetings were merged with discussion and review of Tom Horne's reelection campaign events. These meetings took place on Wednesday's at 2:00 PM in the Attorney General Executive office conference room. I was included in these meetings to verify campaign events as well as fundraisers. See for example the Calendar Committee Meeting forms distributed for use in the August 28, 2013, and October 9, 2013, meetings which clearly identify



events as “Deep blue is political.” These forms were created and distributed by Debra Scordato who is the Executive Assistant to Tom Horne. See Calendar Committee Meeting forms for August 28, 2013, and October 9, 2013, attached hereto as **Exhibit 10**. These Calendar Committee Meeting forms were distributed to members of the Executive Office staff and we discussed campaign issues along with Official issues at the meetings. Other times Ms. Scordato would send campaign calendar reminders in emails from her private email account to members of the Executive Staff on their private email accounts, but these were sent and received during regular business hours. See Email Reminders dated “Wed, Jan 22, 2014” and sent at 4:22 p.m., and “Thu, Feb 13, 2014” and sent at 4:28 p.m., attached hereto as **Exhibit 11**.

16. There were many other instances of Tom Horne campaigning during regular office hours. By way of example, attached to my affidavit are the following emails in support:

- Email exchange between Tom Horne and other members of the Executive Office staff about a proposed Robocall for the campaign dated 12/26/2013 and timed as sent by Horne at 4:26 pm, attached hereto as **Exhibit 12**.
- Email exchange between Tom Horne and other members of the Executive Office staff with an attached memo drafted by Tom Horne, and two Word documents on the “Negatives of Rotellini,” dated January 17, 2014, and timed as sent by Tom Horne at 2:33 p.m., attached hereto as **Exhibit 13**.
- Email from Tom Horne to me and Darline Garrett, with an attached memo entitled “Tom Horne’s Achievements,” dated March 28, 2014, and timed as sent at 11:34 a.m., attached hereto as **Exhibit 14**.

**MARGARET GARCIA DUGAN**

17. Margaret Dugan is the Chief of Staff for the Office of the Arizona Attorney General. Ms. Dugan is also the Campaign Manager for Tom Horne 2014, Tom Horne's reelection campaign. Ms. Dugan regularly blurred the line between those two roles while in the Executive Office. By way of example, Ms. Dugan spent regular office time meeting with Garrett Archer to ensure and review his updated campaign data that he was working on for the Tom Horne 2014 campaign. There was a time when the link to Tom Horne's Twitter account was broken, and she asked me to have Garrett Archer get it fixed.

18. Ms. Dugan would often stop by my desk to talk to me about the status of the campaign fundraisers I was working on, the status of invite flyers, Tom Horne's Twitter account, the Tom Horne 2014 Facebook page, and so forth. In addition, she would often stop by to complain that she did not feel Garrett Archer was working hard enough on the campaign data. Ms. Dugan also would also stop at my desk to tell me that she felt Brett Mecum was slacking on his campaign duties. On several occasions Tom Horne and Ms. Dugan came to my desk and specifically asked me to address their concerns over Garrett's or Brett's lack of campaign work with Garrett and Brett directly, which I did.

19. Lastly, Ms. Dugan also spent time at my desk talking about political events and fundraisers she attended with Tom Horne, or future political events she and Debra Jackson planned to attend on behalf of Tom Horne 2014.

#### **KATHLEEN WINN**

20. Kathleen Winn is the Director of Community Outreach and Education for the Office of the Arizona Attorney General. I was hired by Ms. Winn for the direct purpose that I would work on the campaign to reelect Tom Horne, while working for Community Outreach in the Executive

Office. Kathleen Winn, Brett Mecum and I talked about this arrangement at the very first luncheon before I was hired.

21. At Ms. Winn's direction I began immediately doing campaign related work. By way of example, attached to my affidavit is an email exchange between Ms. Winn and me dated "Tue, Aug 13, 2013," and exchanged between 1:20 p.m. and 2:14 p.m. See **Exhibit 15**. The email asked me to improve the list of Tom Horne's Achievements to use as "a good reference when you are out and about talking to constituents." Ms. Winn's command to me was to "help [her] make this better," and that this job was "Top priority stat." This list of talking points was circulated to nearly all members of the Executive Office multiple times for review and amendment for campaign purposes.

22. Ms. Winn was well aware of me doing campaign work while in the Executive Office and during regular working hours. By way of example, attached to my affidavit is an email I sent to Brett Mecum, Kathleen Winn, Margaret Dugan and Debra Scordato, asking everyone on the email to use their personal connections to secure campaign endorsements for Tom Horne. See email dated "Wed, Sep 11, 2013," and sent at 7:46 a.m., attached hereto as **Exhibit 16**.

23. I shortly learned that Kathleen was surrounded with controversy as well as difficult to work with in the office. While I knowingly came on to work on the campaign to reelect Tom Horne, I did not realize the severity of the accusations against Tom Horne and Kathleen Winn. Ms. Winn said to me and others in the Executive Office, that Tom Horne could never get rid of her because she knew "where all the bodies were buried." Ms. Winn was a frequent participant in the campaign discussions and activities of the Executive Office. And was frequently sending and receiving campaign related emails.

24. On April 8, 2014, I recall going to a campaign meeting at an offsite location. I saw that Kathleen Winn had driven a government vehicle to the campaign site. It was at this point I decided I would no longer be working on Tom Horne's reelection campaign. When I got back to my desk I sent Tom Horne an email and told him I would no longer be working on his campaign. See email dated April 8, 2014, attached hereto as **Exhibit 17**. Tom Horne came out to my desk and asked me to talk to him about the email in his office. I told Tom Horne that I was very uncomfortable with Kathleen Winn using a government car where the public could easily see it being used for his campaign. I told Mr. Horne that I was concerned that because of his ongoing legal problems his office may well be under surveillance. I told Mr. Horne that I was not comfortable with putting my legal wellbeing at risk anymore.

25. One last example of how much Kathleen Winn put this whole campaign at risk can be found in an email exchange dated April 4, 2014, around 3:00 p.m., between Ms. Winn and Dan McCauley, attached hereto as **Exhibit 18**. Mr. McCauley, an attorney, emailed Ms. Winn to advise her that he had reason to believe Tom Horne's office may be sued over a claim of improper distribution of [federal] foreclosure money like the Attorney General of California was. Additionally, Mr. McCauley advised Ms. Winn that he had clients who were victimized by an Arizona lawyer and a well-known local real estate developer. Mr. McCauley suggested that the conduct of these two might be a violation of the Foreign Corrupt Practices Act, and that there was still time to investigate and indict. Mr. McCauley suggested that the real estate developer had been involved "in some of the biggest land swindles in AZ," and told Ms. Winn "If you guys can get him he would be a really big fish." Whether Ms. Winn forwarded this email to the proper divisions within the Office of the Attorney General is not known to me. But what is known is that within minutes of receipt of this email, Ms. Winn forwarded it directly to "Tom

Horne for Attorney General [campaign@electtomhorne.com](mailto:campaign@electtomhorne.com).” This demonstrated to me the complete lack of a firewall between Executive Office official work and campaign work. My interpretation of Ms. Winn’s conduct in forwarding this email to the campaign was to see if “political hay” could be made with it.

#### **DEBRA SCORDATO**

26. Debra Scordato is the Executive Assistant to Tom Horne in the Office of the Arizona Attorney General. Ms. Scordato is also heavily involved in the day-to-day campaigning activities to reelect Tom Horne. By way of example, please see **Exhibit 15**, attached hereto where Ms. Scordato sent an attachment of Tom Horne’s Achievements, advising us “This is a good reference when you are out talking to constituents.”

27. There were many other instances of Debra Scordato campaigning during regular office hours. By way of example, attached to my affidavit are the following emails in support:

- Email from Debra Scordato to myself, Tom Horne, Margaret Dugan, Brett Mecum and Garrett Archer, regarding a fundraiser for Tom Horne to be hosted by Bill McGibbon and Cindy Coping in Green Valley, with two attached documents dated “Tue Dec 3, 2013,” and sent by Debra at 10:04 a.m., attached hereto as **Exhibit 19**.
- Email from Debra Scordato to at least me regarding the fundraiser headlined by Ken Cuccinelli at the home of Don Tapia for the next day with attachment, dated “Wed Dec 4, 2013” sent by Debra at 12:12 p.m., and attached hereto as **Exhibit 20**.
- Email from Debra Scordato to Brett Mecum, myself and Margaret Dugan, regarding upcoming fundraising duties and upcoming campaign events reminders, dated “Wed Jan 22, 2014,” sent by Debra at 4:22 p.m., and attached hereto as **Exhibit 21**.

- Email from Debra Scordato to Margaret Dugan, Stephanie Grisham, myself, Garrett Archer, Brett Mecum, Kathleen Winn and Tom Horne, regarding campaign “To Do’s” and reminders, dated “Thu Feb, 13, 2014,” sent at 4:28 p.m., and attached hereto as **Exhibit 22**.
- Email from Debra Scordato to Brett Mecum, Debra Scordato, Garrett Archer, Larry Weitzner, Margaret Dugan, Mila Makal, myself, Stephanie Grisham, and Tom Horne, regarding Core Campaign Meeting with attached minutes of meeting, dated “Fri Mar 28, 2014,” sent at 11:50 a.m., and attached hereto as **Exhibit 23**.
- Email from Debra Scordato to at least me, regarding Core Campaign Meeting with attached minutes of meeting, dated “Tue, Apr 1, 2014,” sent at 2:54 p.m., and attached hereto as **Exhibit 24**.

#### **BRETT MECUM**

28. Brett Mecum is the Legislative Liaison for the Office of the Arizona Attorney General. Brett Mecum, as I stated above, first approached me about working in the Attorney General’s office. Mr. Mecum wanted me and Garrett Archer to work on Tom Horne’s campaign and he referred to Mr. Archer and me as “the Dream Team” for our campaigning skills. I personally saw, and worked with, Mr. Mecum doing political campaign work to reelect Tom Horne while on official State time.

29. Brett and I worked together designing and developing the fundraiser flyers that are attached to my affidavit. These flyers were sent back and forth using our private email accounts but while on official State time.

30. There were many other instances of Brett Mecum campaigning during regular office hours. By way of example, attached to my affidavit are the following emails in support:

- Email from Brett Mecum to Carmen Chenal and me, about a fundraiser for the Tom Horne reelection campaign to be held at the Scottsdale Airpark, dated “Wed, Aug 28, 2013,” and sent at 12:56 pm, attached hereto as **Exhibit 25**. The issue here is not necessarily the time of day that it was sent, but the metadata shown in Exhibit 25 reflects that Mr. Mecum spent **1222 Minutes** over a two day period editing just the fundraiser flyer.
- Email exchange between Brett Mecum, Carmen Chenal and me, about biscotti bags, bumper stickers and fundraising, dated “Thu, Sep 5, 2013,” and sent between 9:53 a.m., and 4:53 p.m., attached hereto as **Exhibit 26**.
- Email from Brett Mecum to Tom Horne, himself, and me, regarding a fundraiser hosted by the Lindners, dated “Tue, Oct 1, 2013” and sent at 10:01 a.m., attached hereto as **Exhibit 27**.
- Email from Brett Mecum to Tom Horne, Stephanie Grisham, Art Harding, Adria Martinez, Garrett Archer, Margaret Dugan, me, Kathleen Winn, Larry Weitzner , and, Debra Scordato, regarding a recording of Mark Brnovich’s talk at the Arizona Project the day before, dated “Tue, Oct 8, 2013” and sent at 10:41 a.m., attached hereto as **Exhibit 28**.
- Flyer drafted by Brett Mecum, and sent by Garrett Archer to Margaret Dugan, Brett and me, regarding the Cuccinelli fundraiser with an attached flyer for the fundraiser, dated “Tue, Dec 3, 2013,” and sent at 10:07 a.m., and attached hereto as **Exhibit 29**.

**GARRETT ARCHER**


31. Garrett Archer is the State & Federal Relations/Policy Analyst for the Office of the Arizona Attorney General. Mr. Archer is a self-described political data guru who owns his own

political consulting group. Mr. Archer was the other part of Mr. Mecum's "dream team." Mr. Archer did much of the database work for the campaign to reelect Tom Horne. Brett Mecum and I would often meet in Garrett Archer's office during regular office hours to discuss donor lists, voter ID lists, voter information and other campaign related matters.

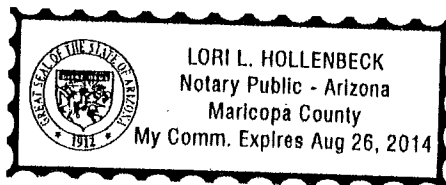

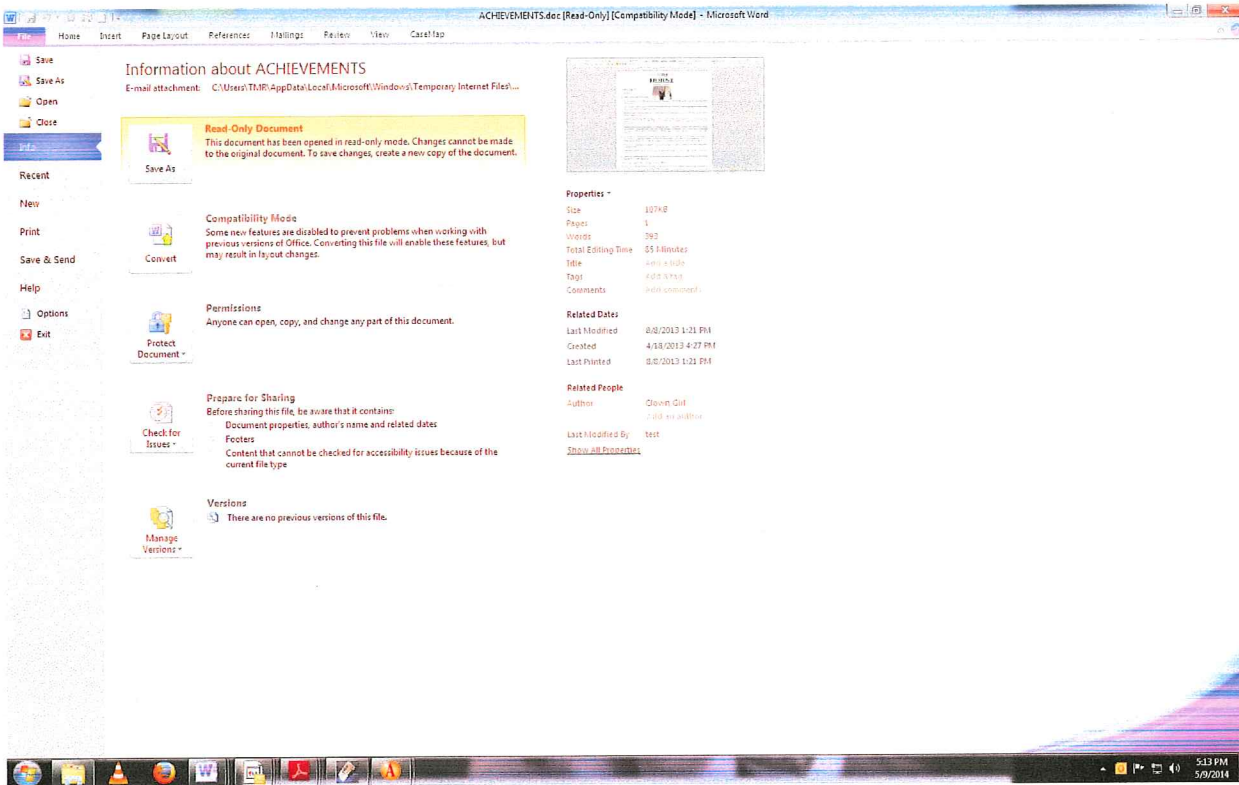


## ACHIEVEMENTS

- 1) Defended SB1070.

RE: Limitations on Political and Campaign Activities of AGO Employees

**As we are moving into another election year, it is time once again to re-issue a reminder that State employees are subject to certain statutory limitations on their political and campaign activity. Please review the attached updated memo regarding Limitations on Political and Campaign Activities of employees of the Attorney General's Office. This memo updates and replaces the guidance previously issued on September 26, 2008. The same "do's" and "don'ts" apply as in previous years, but due to the recent personnel reform legislation, the statutory citations have changed and who the limitations apply to has changed. Please pay particular attention to the section on Exemptions. If you have any question about whether certain limitations on political and campaign activity apply to you, consult your supervisor, Human Resources, and/or Special Counsel for Ethics & Training.**

As state employees, employees of the Arizona Attorney General's Office are subject to certain restrictions on their campaign and political activities. These restrictions apply irrespective of party affiliation or intended support of candidates or ballot measures. The state restrictions (Arizona's "mini-Hatch Act") are found at A.R.S. § 41-752.<sup>1</sup> The public policy behind these limitations is at A.R.S. § 41-752(K), which states:

It is the public policy of this state, reflected in this section, that government programs be administered in an unbiased manner and without favoritism for or against any political party or group or any member in order to promote public confidence in government, governmental integrity and the efficient delivery of governmental services and to ensure that all employees are free from any express or implied requirement or any political or other pressure of any kind to engage or not engage in any activity permitted by this section. Toward this end, any person or entity charged with the interpretation of this section shall take into account the

policy of this section and shall construe any of its provisions accordingly.

The statutes regulating political activity by State employees attempt to strike a permissible balance between an employee's constitutional rights and the rightful interests of the State. The governmental interests advanced include: (1) an enhanced government work force of efficient, apolitical employees, and (2) an enhanced appearance of impartiality. *Fernandez v. Personnel Bd.*, 175 Ariz. 39, 41, 852 P.2d 1223, 1225 (App. 1992) (holding A.R.S. § 41-772<sup>2</sup> was not unconstitutionally broad and did not violate the First and Fourteenth Amendments). Another goal is to insure that employment and advancement in Government service are not dependant on political performance, and that government employees are free from pressure to vote in a particular way or perform political chores in order to curry favor with their supervisors rather than act on their own beliefs. Ariz. Atty. Gen. Op. I83-134, citing *United States Civil Service Comm'n v. National Assoc. of Letter Carriers*, 413 U.S. 548 (1973).

#### **APPEARANCE OF IMPROPRIETY**

This office strives to avoid even the appearance of impropriety. Keep in mind at all times that your comments and actions may reflect on the credibility and integrity of the Attorney General and this office. If you are in doubt about whether a particular activity is permissible under state or federal law, consult with your supervisor, Human Resources and/or Special Counsel for Ethics & Training before you engage in the activity, and always err on the side of caution. Avoid any conduct that would create the appearance that you are using your state position to support or oppose a political candidate, or that state resources are, were, or may be used to further any political campaign. Avoid any conduct that might call your motives, truthfulness or integrity into question, or might reflect adversely upon the Attorney General or this office.

#### **PROHIBITED POLITICAL ACTIVITY – A.R.S. § 41-752**

**State Employees SHALL NOT (on or off duty or at public expense):**

- use any political endorsement in connection with any appointment to a state position (§ 41-752(B)(1))
- use or promise to use any official authority or influence for the purpose of influencing the vote or political action of any person or for any consideration (§ 41-752(B)(2))
- be a member of any national, state or local committee of a political party (§ 41-752(C))

- be an officer or chairman of a committee of a partisan political club (§ 41-752(C))
- be a candidate for nomination or election to any paid public office (§ 41-752(C))<sup>3</sup>
- hold any paid elective public office (§ 41-752(C))
- take part in the management or affairs of any political party or in the management of any partisan or nonpartisan campaign or recall effort ( 41-752(C))
  - serve on an election board if appointed by the county chairman of any party pursuant to A.R.S. § 16-531(A) (Ariz. Atty. Gen. Op. 193-001)
  - run and serve as a delegate to a Presidential Convention (Ariz. Atty. Gen. Op. 193-001)
  - “political campaign” as used in A.R.S. § 41-772(B) does not include initiative campaigns. (Ariz. Atty. Gen. Op. 190-054)

#### **PERMITTED POLITICAL ACTIVITY**

##### **State Employees MAY (off duty and not at public expense):**

- attend meetings to become informed concerning candidates and political issues (§ 41-752(C)(2))
- sign nomination or recall petitions (§ 41-752(C)(3))
- make contributions to candidates, political parties or campaign committees (§ 41-752(C)(4))
- circulate nomination or recall petitions (§ 41-752(C)(5))
- engage in activities to advocate the election or defeat of any candidate (§ 41-752(C)(6))
- solicit or encourage contributions to be made directly to candidates or campaign committees (§ 41-752(C)(7))

---

<sup>3</sup> One does not become a “candidate” under A.R.S. § 41-752(C) until nomination papers are filed. A.R.S. § 16-311. Up to the point of filing, an employee may take other preliminary steps such as filing petitions or forming campaign committees without resigning his or her position.

- participate in an initiative or referendum campaign, circulate and sign initiative or referendum petitions (Ariz. Atty. Gen. Op. I90-054)
- serve on an election board if appointed by the Board of Supervisors without recommendation of the county chairman of any party (Ariz. Atty. Gen. Op. I93-001)
- serve as deputy registrar as long as appointed without nomination or recommendation of a political party (Ariz. Atty. Gen. Op. I93-001)
- serve as a member of the governing board of a common or high school district or as a member of a community college district governing board (§ 41-752(F))
- Other: assist in voter registration drives, attend political rallies, meetings and fundraisers, host a political fundraiser in your home, be a member of a political party or club, distribute campaign literature, make campaign speeches for candidates in partisan elections

**State Employees MAY (on *and* off duty):**

- vote (§ 16-402; § 41-752(C)(3))
- express your opinion on candidates and issues (§ 41-752(A)); (§ 41-752(C)(1)); *see also* 5 U.S.C. § 7324(b)
  - wear a political button, badge or t-shirt, and display a bumper sticker on any personal vehicle (Ariz. Atty. Gen. Op. I87-028; *see also* 5 C.F.R. § 733.111, which sets out permissible activities under the federal Hatch Act)
  - **Note:** Although it may be permissible to wear political buttons, etc. while on duty, employees who interact with the public should be urged to exercise discretion because of the risk of creating the appearance of using one's official position to influence an election. Employees must also comply at all times with their agency's dress code.

**PROHIBITION AGAINST ENCOURAGING OR DISCOURAGING STATE EMPLOYEES FROM ENGAGING IN POLITICAL ACTIVITY BY MEANS OF THREATS, INTIMIDATION OR COERCION (A.R.S. §§ 41-752(D)(1) – (3))**

A.R.S. §§ 41-752(D)(1) – (3) prohibits a person from direct or indirect threats of discrimination, reprisal, force or any other adverse consequence such as loss of benefits, rewards, promotion, advancement or compensation to get a State



employee to participate in, refrain from participating in, or to stop participation in permitted political activity.

In addition, A.R.S. §§ 16-1012 and 1013 prohibit intimidation or coercion of electors. It is a class 1 misdemeanor for an employer, within 90 days of an election, to put up or exhibit in the workplace a handbill, notice or placard containing a threat, notice or information that if any particular ticket or candidate is elected or defeated, work will cease or the establishment will be closed, wages will be reduced, or other express or implied threats intended to influence the political opinions or actions of the employees. A.R.S. § 16-1012. It also is unlawful to threaten or intimidate anyone to induce or compel that person to vote or refrain from voting for a particular person or measure, or on account of such person having voted or refrained from voting at an election, or to prevent or interfere with the free exercise of the elective franchise of any voter. A.R.S. § 16-1013.

In other words, don't try to get someone to participate or not participate in political activity by direct or indirect threats to take some sort of adverse action against them. Although it is permissible to express your opinions on political issues while at work, you need to exercise discretion. Supervisors and persons in positions of authority in particular should keep in mind that subordinate employees might misinterpret the expression of an opinion about a political issue and feel pressured to conform their conduct accordingly, even where that was not the intention of the speaker.

### **CONSEQUENCES FOR VIOLATION**

An employee who engages in restricted political activity is subject to suspension of not less than thirty days or dismissal. A.R.S. § 41-752(G). An employee who violates A.R.S. §§ 41-752(D) is guilty of a class 6 felony. A.R.S. § 41-752(H)(1). Violation of any of the other provisions is a class 1 misdemeanor. A.R.S. § 41-752(H)(2). Further, any person soliciting or encouraging a contribution in a manner prohibited by this section are subject to a civil penalty up to three times the amount of the contribution plus costs, expenses and attorneys fees. A.R.S. § 41-752(I).

### **EXEMPTIONS**

The limitations on political activity set forth in A.R.S. § 41-752(B) and (C) do not apply to elected state officers such as the Attorney General (A.R.S. § 41-742(D)(1)). Certain other state employees also are exempt from these limitations. A.R.S. § 752(E). In the Attorney General's Office, employees who are exempt from the limitations on political activity set forth in A.R.S. § 41-752(B) and (C) include:

- Employees who report directly to the Attorney General (A.R.S. § 41-742(F)(2)(a)). These employees include the Chief Deputy, Chief of Staff, and employees of the Executive Division who

- report directly to the Attorney General.
- Employees who head a primary component or report directly to the head of a primary component of the office of the Attorney General (A.R.S. § 41-742(F)(2)(b)). These employees include Division Chiefs, Section Chiefs, and other employees who report directly to a Division Chief.
- Employees whose primary duties include determining or publicly advocating substantive program policy for the office of the elected official (A.R.S. § 41-742(F)(2)(c)).
- Attorneys in the office of the Attorney General (A.R.S. § 41-742(F)(5)).

It can be difficult to determine whether some positions are exempt from the limitations on political activity or not, especially since some positions in a particular job category might be exempt, depending on the reporting structure, and some may not be exempt. If you are unsure whether your position is exempt from these limitations, contact your supervisor, Human Resources or Special Counsel for Ethics & Training.

## USE OF PUBLIC RESOURCES

Although public officers and employees may engage in certain types of political activity, no public resources may be used for this purpose. No public employee may participate in any political or campaign work while on the public's time, use public facilities, materials, and equipment for political or campaign activity, or travel at public expense for non-public purposes.<sup>4</sup>

### What does this mean?

- You must put in a full work week. If you engage in political activity during your normal working hours, you must take annual leave to do so. Do not commingle work on a campaign or political activity with your work time.
- Do not use government equipment, property, supplies or materials for political purposes. This includes phones, computers, pagers, Blackberry and other electronic devices, state vehicles, paper, fax machines. A.A.C. R2-5-501(c)(5), A.A.C. R2-10-107 (state vehicles).
- Do not send campaign-related or other political e-mail from your state computers or Blackberry. See Attorney General's Internet and E-Mail Policy, section V(I). If you receive campaign-related e-mail on your state computer, delete it and contact the sender(s) to request that they refrain from sending campaign material at work.

<sup>4</sup> Public officials may travel at public expense if the expenses are incurred while "traveling on necessary public business away from his designated post of duty and when issued a proper travel order." A.R.S. § 38-621(A).

- The Internet and E-Mail policy permits limited personal use of the internet during personal time (*see* section V). Pursuant to this policy, merely accessing a partisan political website would not violate this policy or A.R.S. § 41-752.
- Do not conduct political meetings in your government office.
- Do not use your title or affiliation with this office when engaging in permitted political activities.

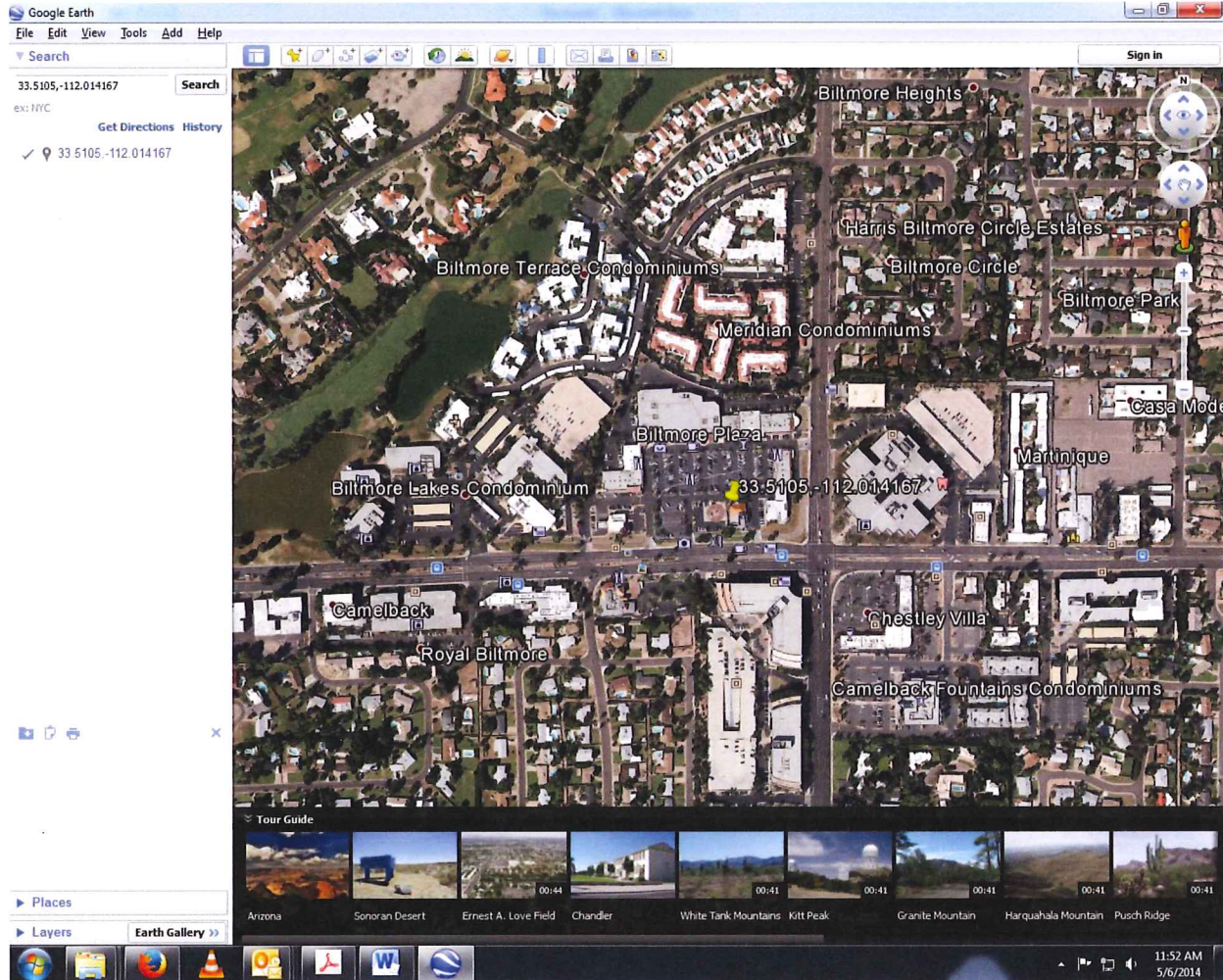

## DETAILED ATTACHMENTS FOR NEGATIVES ON ROTELLINI

1. The following is a memorandum sent to Arizona Republic Fact Check IN 2010. It was written by Charles Johnson who was an assistant Attorney General for 28 years, including all of the years that Rotellini was in the AG's office.

He indicates that he was "surprised to hear Felicia Rotellini...claiming to be an experienced prosecutor/trial lawyer." He provides detailed documentation showing "she is an experienced desk lawyer giving advice to State Agency's, but is not a court room veteran..." In fact, he demonstrates with detailed documentation that during her years in the Attorney General's Office, she never tried a single case to a jury. For someone to claim to the public that she is "a veteran prosecutor" when she never tried a single case to a jury in all of her years in the Attorney General's Office is an attempt at fraud on the public. Here is the detailed memorandum that he prepared:

To: Arizona Republic Fact Check

...I was surprised to hear Felicia Rotellini, who was an Ass't AG for 14 of my 28 years as an Ass't AG (1981-2009) claiming to be an experienced prosecutor/trial lawyer.

Please find attached the supporting documentation for my conclusion, based upon a review of the eight cases she provided to you, & my practice in the AG's Office, that not only is she not an experienced prosecutor/trial lawyer, she has never been to trial in any civil or criminal case. She is an experienced desk lawyer giving advice to State agencies, but is not a courtroom veteran as is Tom Horne.

No trial, to a Jury or to a Judge, occurred in any of the eight cases which the Rotellini campaign provided to the Arizona Republic in a failed attempt to demonstrate her legal experience.

In five of the six criminal cases she listed which resulted in guilty pleas, not a trial, she was not the attorney of record for the State at the time the case was pled out by a guilty plea. In five of those cases, another Ass't AG had become the prosecutor before the defendant pled guilty. No trial occurred in the two civil cases she listed, and she was not even the principal attorney for any party, but rather was merely the junior of the two attorneys who represented her client.

Her eight case list posted on the Arizona Republic's website is set forth below. The history of the case is summarized in brackets following each case listed by the Rotellini campaign.

"List of cases from Rotellini campaign spokesman Dave Cieslak:

In the following six cases, Felecia appeared before the Arizona State Grand Jury to obtain the indictments, and then spent time in Maricopa County Superior Court:

- *State v. William Crotts, Thomas Grabinski, Harold Friend, Lawrence Hoover, Richard Rolfus* CR2001-006183 (Baptist Foundation criminal case and securities fraud). Referral from the Arizona Corporation Commission."

[Felicia admits by the foregoing description that her much touted success in the so-called Baptist Foundation case was limited to the grand jury indictment and "then [she] spent time in Maricopa County Superior Court." She played no role in the trial at all. Another Ass't AG was the prosecutor in the criminal trial which resulted in the convictions of two Baptist Foundation officers in August 2006. Ms. Rotellini withdrew from the case eight months earlier when she was appointed the Superintendent of the Department of Financial Institutions in January, 2006. Ms. Rotellini's role in the so-called Baptist Foundation case was in an administrative action in which the Arthur Anderson CPA firm consented to pay restitution for its negligent accounting work performed for the Baptist Foundation, after it was clear that the Arthur Anderson CPA firm could not survive its negligent accounting for ENRON.]

"- *State v. David Paul French and James Anthony Cicerella*, CR2003-013117 (ponzi scheme; securities fraud). Referral from Arizona Corporation Commission."

[No trial. Felicia admits above by the foregoing description that her role in this case was limited to the grand jury indictment, "then [she] spent time in Maricopa County Superior Court." She was replaced as the prosecutor by Ass't AG's Jeff Reuter and later Ed Noyes, who obtained the guilty plea resolving the case.]

"- *State v. Manuel A Perez*, CR2003-013118 (fraud and theft, real-estate sales related). Referral from the Arizona Department of Real Estate." [No conviction; no trial; defendant fled. Felicia admits above by the foregoing description that her role in this case was limited to the grand jury indictment, "then [she] spent time in Maricopa County Superior Court." The major activity in the case was performed by a Deputy Maricopa County Attorney, Peter Spaw, who obtained forfeiture of the defendant's bail bond after he fled.]

"-*State v. Hal Fields*, CR2003-024924 and CR2004-007688 (fraud and theft, real-estate related) Rreferral [sic] from the Arizona Department of Real Estate and HUD. "[No trial. Felicia admits above by the foregoing description that her role in this case was limited to the grand jury indictment, "then [she] spent time in Maricopa County Superior Court." She was replaced as the prosecutor by Ass't AG Ed Noyes, who obtained the guilty plea resolving the case.]

"-*State v. Nora Elana Escobar*, CR2004-012957 (identity theft). Referral from U.S. Postal Inspector." [No trial. Felicia admits above by the foregoing description that her role in this case was limited to the grand jury indictment, "then [she] spent time in Maricopa County Superior Court." She was replaced

as the prosecutor by Ass't AG's Jacqueline Schesmol and later Ed Noyes, who obtained the guilty plea resolving the case.]

"-*State v. Heidi Jo Jauger [sic], Richard E. Valentin, Julie Davis*, CR2004-007689 (theft, embezzlement). Investigated by Attorney General's Office." [No trial. Felicia admits above by the foregoing description that her role in this case was limited to the grand jury indictment, "then [she] spent time in Maricopa County Superior Court," and she obtained the guilty plea resolving the case. The defendant's name is Jaeger, not Jauger]

"The next two are civil cases in which Felicia argued in court:

- *Morton Roberts v. State*, 179 Ariz. 613, 880 P.2d 1159 (App. 1994)." [No trial. Felicia admits above by the foregoing description that her role in this case was limited to "Felicia argued in court." This was an administrative agency action, appealed to the County Superior Court then to the Court of Appeals, in which Ms. Rotellini was joined by another Ass't AG, Leslie Hall.]

"- *Milliken & Michaels of Arizona v. Houseworth*, 942 F. Supp 454 (1996). - 28-day civil hearing before a judge, then Milliken and Michaels sued the state in federal court. In front of Judge Carroll for six months." [No trial. Felicia admits above by the foregoing description that her role in this case was limited to "Felicia argued in court." She was not the lead attorney for the State in the reported federal case; that was former Solicitor General for the AG's Office Anthony Ching.]

The law firm, Zwilling & Greek, where Felicia practices law, lists on its website 3 reported cases evidencing her legal expertise, but her list sent to the AZ Republic omits one of them, *O'Brien v. State of Wyoming*, 711 P.2d 1145 (Wyo. 1986). In that case, which also was not a trial, she was a legal intern, not admitted to practice yet. Neither she nor the attorney supervising her represented a party, but rather submitted an amicus (friend of the Court) brief in favor of the State.

Although the Western Union case was not listed on the eight case lists, her campaign website touts that successful case in support of her candidacy. However, in that case, she was not the prosecutor or a litigator, but rather she was the client (as Superintendent of DFI) in an administrative consent order obtained by Assistant AG Craig Raby, and also assisted by at least six additional Assistant Attorneys General who actually litigated civil cases in state and federal court and investigated a criminal case against Western Union. Those civil and criminal cases against Western Union, in which Ms. Rotellini was neither a lawyer for any party or even a client, resulted in a \$94 million consent judgment against Western Union. Ms. Rotellini resigned her position as head of DFI in August, 2009 and in September, 2009 announced her run for AG, several months before that \$94 million settlement was achieved...

2. The following is a detailed letter dated November 21, 2006, in which the firm of Snell & Wilmer warns the then Attorney General, with a carbon copy to Felicia Rotellini as Director of Financial Institutions, that the firm of Mortgages LTD was engaging in serious fraud. Among other thing, there were "interest kickbacks" and "an extortionate" rate of interest in excess of 63%. (Page 6 of letter.) As Director of The Department of Financial Institutions, Rotellini's job was to put a stop to these kinds of fraudulent practices. Instead, she ignored it. As a result, Mortgages LTD continued doing business, and ultimately became the biggest fraud in the history of Arizona, costing innocent people over \$1 billion in losses, which deprived very large numbers of people of their life savings. This letter is followed by a letter sent directly to Rotellini to be sure she paid careful attention to the longer letter on which she was copied, but she refused to do so, directly resulting in \$1 billion of losses to Arizona citizens, including many losing their life's savings.

Dear Ms. Segal:

As we have briefly discussed, our firm agreed to take on representation of Covenant Christian Center International, Inc. (the "Church") as a *pro bono* client. We have summarized below the transactions between the Church and Mortgages Ltd. that upon informal investigation have led us to conclude that the Church has been a victim of Mortgages Ltd.'s illegal and predatory loan scheme.

### The Acquisition of the Property and Terms of the Loan

On March 2, 2005, Mortgages Ltd., an Arizona licensed broker, placed a one-year Acquisition loan to the Church, as borrower. The basic terms of the loan were \$1,075,000

principal at 11.5% interest, interest paid monthly, with maturity in March 2006.<sup>3</sup> With the amount of discounts and fees that were deducted, the Promissory Notes effective rate of interest was 16.25% on the amount advanced, or \$1,030,061.<sup>4</sup> The effective rate of interest was for one year, with interest only payments until maturity. The loan was secured by a First Deed of Trust

on the property.' The Church, which has a primarily minority congregation, acquired the property at a discount from the seller. A back-up bid received at the time was at \$1,700,000. The loan information sheet to investors showed "Appraisal Value \$0" and "Income \$0."<sup>6</sup> M01tgages Ltd. appears to have retained some portion of the loan for its own account.

Under the Church Promissory Note, default interest accrues at 27% per annum, but expressly states that a separate "late fee" would also accrue simultaneously at 36% per annum. The late fee is not a one-time event, but rather accumulates with each month. The resulting effective interest rate is 63% per annum and 67.75% in light of the original loan discount. See *Morrison v. Shanwick Inter. Corp.*, 167 Ariz. 39 (Ct. App. 1991) (fees that function as interest are viewed as interest for purposes of state statutes).

#### Loan Maturity and Assignment of Note to New Hope

All interim interest payments were made until the loan maturity date, March 4, 2006.<sup>7</sup> The Church leaders state that they were led to believe the loan would be extended past the March 2006 maturity, if the 11.5% monthly interest payments continued, in order for the Church to arrange other financing. During the final period leading to maturity, the Church leadership states that they were not receiving call backs when people tried to speak with Mortgages Ltd. as to the extension.

Sunday, March 5, 2006, was the first past-due date after maturity. Nevertheless, by Wednesday, March 8, 2006, Mortgages Ltd. had negotiated a new loan venture with New Hope Partners, LLP, an entity wholly owned by Malcolm and Ellen Jozoff of Paradise Valley, Arizona. Facially, it appeared to the outside world that New Hope had simply acquired the Church Promissory Note. The new venture was closed on Thursday, March 6, 2006, with New Hope sending the bulk of the purchase by wire (\$1,144,944), with one portion by check (\$15,146). The primary documents were a "Loan Sale Agreement" and a "Performance Plus Agency Agreement," which until recently were concealed from the Church.<sup>8</sup>

#### The Terms of the Loan Sale Agreement and the Performance Plus Agency Agreement

The Loan Sale Agreement was, in fact, a new joint venture between Mortgages Ltd. and New Hope. Despite being a defaulted loan, M01tgages Ltd. sold the Church Promissory Note for a premium, specifically a payment of \$1,160,090.11, reflecting the full principal, all accrued interest, plus a \$16,125 "fee." The \$16,125 fee to Mortgages Ltd. is described in the Loan Sale Agreement as:

4.2 As part of the Purchase Price set forth herein, Purchaser [New Hope] shall pay Mortgages Ltd. an "Agency Fee" in the amount of \$16,125.00 in immediately available funds on or before the Closing Date. This Agency Fee is separate and apart from any other obligations set forth in the Agency Agreement.

This \$16,125 fee paid as a premium for the defaulted loan later was added onto the payoff balance of the loan; in other words, the Church (as borrower) would have to pay for the premium/profit received by Mortgages Ltd. for selling a defaulted loan.<sup>9</sup>

The most bizarre sections of the Loan Sale Agreement, however, are Sections 4.3 and 4.4. Section 4.3 splits up the loan recovery so that the principal and 18% of the interest on the loan go to New Hope, but all "excess" interest would be a kick-back to Mortgages Ltd. Specifically, the Loan Sale Agreement states:

4.3 In addition to the Agency Fee set forth in Section 4.2, Purchaser agrees to pay to Mortgages Ltd. an additional fee equal to the interest received by Purchaser on the Loan in excess of Eighteen percent (18%) per annum as a result of a reinstatement of the Loan or Payment of the balance of the Loan. Said additional fee shall be paid at the time of such reinstatement of the Loan or payment of the balance due on the Loan.

Then Section 4.4 of the Loan Sale Agreement requires New Hope to use Mortgages Ltd.'s attorneys "in the trustee sale proceedings and all other matters relating to the enforcement of the Loan Documents":

4.4 The law firm of Gust Rosenfeld P.L.C. shall continue as attorney and trustee for Purchaser in the trustee sale proceedings and all other matters relating to the enforcement of the Loan Documents. However, Gust Rosenfeld P.L.C. has not acted as attorney for Purchaser with regard to this Loan Sale Agreement. Purchaser has had the opportunity to select alternative counsel with regard to this Loan Sale Agreement. Copies of all recorded documents filed by the Trustee relating to the Foreclosure action for the loan are attached hereto as Exhibit K.

The Loan Sale Agreement recites that New Hope is buying the defaulted Loan "AS IS" (§ 9.1), with an express acknowledgment that the loan "is presently in default" and is the subject of foreclosure (§ 9.2). Similarly, the trust property is described "AS IS" (§ 10.1). Nevertheless,

New Hope acknowledges that it "is acting as independent investor in *this* transaction with the expectation of profit" (§ 17.5).

The Loan Sale Agreement was accompanied by Exhibit "H," the "Performance Plus Agency Agreement." In *this* document, New Hope and Mortgages Ltd. agreed that Mortgages Ltd. would keep "any and all fees and charges assessed under the Loan Documents (§ 1(7)(c) ("Compensation"))." Section 1(7)(d) then goes on to confirm the arrangement for the division of the default interest:

d. Default Interest. A portion of Default interest collected shall be payable to Beneficiary. Such amount shall not exceed Eighteen percent (18%) per annum.

In a later provision, § 5 of the Agency Agreement allows New Hope to sell its rights under

the Loan Sale Agreement, but in such an event has to pay Mortgages Ltd. "all compensation due." In light of the language, New Hope would have to pay off all the accrued default interest allocated to Mortgages Ltd. in order to sell off its ownership of the Church Promissory Note.

The Agency Agreement then contains an extremely long set of "Confidentiality" requirements (§ 6). Among other things, subsection 6c(5), required New Hope "not to give testimony against Agent [Mortgages Ltd.] in any legal proceeding to which Agent is a party, unless compelled to do so by competent legal authority."

In sum, New Hope and Mortgages Ltd. set up a joint venture to exploit a defaulted loan. The subject property is located on the west end of a commercial strip mall at 83rd Avenue and Peoria Avenue in Peoria. Because of the location of a Wal-Mart and the nearby stadium developments, the property, once stripped of an operating church, would be a valuable target. In the meantime, New Hope would receive its principal and 18% of the default interest, and Mortgages Ltd. would receive the other 45% of interest and all fees; fees (exclusive of interest and "late charges") are currently being asserted by Mortgages Ltd. at over \$125,000. These amounts are not simply theoretical charges under badly written documents; Mortgages Ltd. is actively demanding payment of all conceivable amounts. The most recent payoff statement of October 11, 2006, from Mortgages Ltd. plainly describes the egregious nature of this loan: a loan with a current balance of \$1,075,000 in February 2006 now is claimed to have a balance of \$1,657,671.49.

#### The Foreclosure Proceedings and Forbearance Fee

Immediately after the New Hope deal closed on March 9, 2006, Mortgages, Ltd. moved quickly on the enforcement of loan remedies against the Church. On Wednesday, March 15, 2006, formal default notices were delivered. A notice of foreclosure of the Church property by Trustee's sale under the Deed of Trust was quickly recorded, with a sale date set for July 6,

2006. On April 11, 2006, "Mortgages Ltd. as servicing agent for New Hope Partners" sued Pastor Stacy Lee, the Church's pastor, and his wife, Michelle Adair Lee, on their personal guarantees of the Church loan. Despite repeated attempts by the Church to obtain extensions from Mortgages Ltd., Mortgages Ltd. agreed to postpone the trustee's sale for 25 days only, "with no further extensions granted regardless of whether or not the bridge loan financing is funded," but only for a non-refundable payment of \$32,250. None of this \$32,250 was to be applied to the principal or interest balance of the Note. Mortgages Ltd. appears to have pocketed the money as its "fee," as allocated to its side of the ledger under the Loan Sale Agreement with New Hope.

#### The Church Files for Bankruptcy Protection

On August 3, 2006, the Church in desperation filed a Chapter 11 proceeding to avert the foreclosure (U.S. Bankruptcy Court, District of Arizona, Case No. 2:06-bk-02386-CGC). The Gust Rosenfeld firm appeared initially as counsel for "Mortgages Ltd. as agent for New Hope."<sup>10</sup>

#### Mortgages Ltd.'s Concealment of the Loan Sale Agreement and Agency Agreement

After being pressed about the Bankruptcy Rule on representation of more than one party (Rule 2019), the Gust Rosenfeld firm filed a formal Rule 2019 Statement, attaching a January 2005 general "Agency Agreement," which made no reference to the Church loan. Calls were placed to the Gust firm requesting the terms of the New Hope loan sale (required under Bankruptcy Rule 2019(c)). After not receiving a response, a formal objection was filed in the Bankruptcy Court to the Rule 2019 Statement on October 4, 2006. Within a few hours, Sean O'Brien of the Gust firm telephoned and stated that there were additional documents about the loan transfer that he had not known about. That evening, the previously secret Loan Sale Agreement and the Agency Agreement, which contained the interest and fee kick-back terms, were revealed to the Church for the first time.

No explanation has ever been offered as to why the wrong agency agreement had been presented to the Court or why the Loan Sale Agreement had been concealed. Even at this point, the concealed documents were not disclosed to the Bankruptcy Court until after the Church filed them in the Court record. Upon further review, the last page of the Loan Sale Agreement showed that the Agreement had attachments "A" through "K" that had *still* not been provided. Only after further demand were the rest of the loan sale documents produced on Friday, October 6th.

#### Conclusion- Illegal and Predatory Loan Scheme

Covenant Christian Center, International, Inc. believes that its congregation has been the victim of an illegal and predatory loan scheme. This scheme constitutes an extortionate extension of credit under A.R.S. § 13-2302, *et seq.* While publicly complaining about non-payment of the loan, in fact, Mortgages Ltd. and New Hope set up a venture to profit on a matured loan, with New Hope paying a premium for the "defaulted loan." The parties then affirmatively concealed the terms of their division of interest and fees, with public recordings silent as to the interest kick-back to Mortgages Ltd. in violation of A.R.S. § 33-404. The entire scheme is predicated on collection of interest at an extortionate rate in excess of 63% (67.25% APR). At a minimum, the loan scheme is in bad faith and predatory in character; legitimate lenders do not pay a premium for a defaulted loan, with the clear intent of profiting. If the additional suggestions of other unfair practices are correct, Mortgages Ltd. appears to be engaged in a serious breach of proper mortgage brokerage practices as regulated by the State of Arizona under A.R.S. §§ 6-906, 6-907, and 6-909. Based upon inquiries with other attorneys in Phoenix, this scheme may be a pattern of illegal loan activity conducted by Mortgages Ltd.

We earnestly request the assistance of the State of Arizona in investigating these companies and their practices. A copy of this letter is being forwarded to Ms. Rotellini at the Department of Financial Institutions.
