Dear Secretary of State Reagan,

I transmit to you Senate Bill 1191, sponsored by Senator Kelli Ward. I am outside of the state today and have every intention of signing this bill. Because this bill imposes a moratorium on the graduation requirement to pass the AIMS assessment set to be administered statewide beginning on Monday, February 23, 2015, I ask that you sign this bill as acting governor immediately.

The Legislature has passed this bill with an emergency clause, and signing the bill today provides certainty to our public schools that the assessment need not take place and assures parents and teachers that this assessment does not impact graduation requirements.
