Federal Funding Update

Steven Eddy, Chair, External Relations







The partial federal government shutdown is in its third week. It remains unclear when a deal will be reached to reopen the shuttered agencies. Federal funding for public broadcasting was already signed into law and is not affected by the shutdown.

On the Senate Health, Education, Labor and Pensions (HELP) Committee, the leadership will remain the same with Senator Lamar Alexander (R-TN) as Chairman and Senator Patty Murray (D-VVA) as Ranking Member. New members on the HELP Committee include Senators Mike Braun (R-IN), Mitt Romney (R-UT) and Jacky Rosen (D-INV).

On the Senate Budget Committee, Michael B. Enzi (R-WY) will remain Chairman and Bernie Sanders (D-VT) will remain Ranking Member. New members on the Budget Committee include Senators Mike Braun (R-IN), Kevin Cramer (R-ND) and Rick Scott (R-FL).

Senator Roger Wicker (R-MS) has been named the new Chair of the Committee on Commerce, Science and Transportation and the new Ranking Member will be Senator Maria Cantwell (D-WA). New Commerce Committee members include Senators Marsha Blackburn (R-TN), Rick Scott (R-FL), Jacky Rosen (D-NV) and Kyrsten Sinema (D-AZ).

Ron Johnson (R-WI) will again serve as Chairman of the Senate Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs Committee with Gary Peters (D-MI) serving as the new Ranking Member. New members to the committee include Senators Josh Hawley (R-MO), Mitt Romney (R-UT), Rick Scott (R-FL), Jacky Rosen (D-NV) and Kyrsten Sinema (D-AZ).
