The grand jurors of the County of Pima, in the name of the State of Arizona, and by its authority accuse MURAD CAN DERVISH, and charge that in Pima County:

COUNT ONE: FIRST DEGREE MURDER, A CLASS ONE FELONY

On or about the 5th day of October, 2022, MURAD CAN DERVISH murdered THOMAS MEIXNER, in violation of A.R.S. 13-1105.

COUNT TWO: AGGRAVATED ASSAULT, DEADLY WEAPON/DANGEROUS INSTRUMENT, A CLASS THREE FELONY

On or about the 5th day of October, 2022, MURAD CAN DERVISH assaulted [REDACTED] with a deadly weapon or dangerous instrument, to wit: FIREARM, in violation of A.R.S. § 13-1204A2.

COUNT THREE: BURGLARY IN THE FIRST DEGREE, A CLASS THREE FELONY

On or about the 5th day of October, 2022, MURAD CAN DERVISH committed burglary in the first degree of a non-residential structure or fenced commercial yard or residential yard, belonging to UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA, while knowingly possessing a deadly weapon or dangerous instrument, to wit: FIREARM, in violation of A.R.S. § 13-1508A.

COUNT FOUR: POSSESSION OF DEADLY WEAPON BY PROHIBITED POSSESSOR, A CLASS FOUR FELONY

On or about the 5th day of October, 2022, MURAD CAN DERVISH, knowingly possessed a deadly weapon, to wit: FIREARM, while having been convicted of a felony, in violation of A.R.S. § 13-3102A4.

COUNT FIVE: ENDANGERMENT, A CLASS SIX FELONY

On or about the 5th day of October, 2022, MURAD CAN DERVISH recklessly endangered [REDACTED] with a substantial risk of imminent death, in violation of A.R.S. § 13-1201A.

COUNT SIX: ENDANGERMENT, A CLASS SIX FELONY

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On or about the 5th day of October, 2022, MURAD CAN DERVISH recklessly endangered [REDACTED] with a substantial risk of imminent death, in violation of A.R.S. § 13-1201A.

COUNT SEVEN: ENDANGERMENT, A CLASS SIX FELONY




