In Case of Emergency



CALL or **TEXT** 9-1-1

When calling to report an emergency



- Identify yourself.
- Identify the location as the University of Arizona to immediately be connected to UAPD.
- Carefully explain the problem to the dispatcher.
- Remain on the phone until the dispatcher tells you to hang up.

Active Shooter / Armed Individual

RUN



If you have a clear exit HIDE



Do whatever you can to make the room seem empty



As a last resort if your life is in danger

Medical Emergencies Call 9-1-1

- Do not move the person unless they are in immediate danger.
- Do not provide aid beyond basic first aid unless
- If the person is unconscious, check pulse and breathing and perform CPR if necessary.



Disruptive Individual / **Violent Incident**

If the individual is an imminent danger or threat,

- Call 9-1-1 immediately.
- Maintain as much physical distance from the individual as possible.
- Try to de-escalate the situation verbally until help arrives.

If no immediate threat, use the QR code below for detailed procedures to follow.



Bomb Threat / Suspicious Package

- Do not touch, move, or open a suspicious object. If you have opened it, remain calm.
- Call 9-1-1 immediately. Close off the area if possible.
 - Evacuate the immediate area.
 - Limit the use of two-way radios and cell phones near the suspicious item.



Hazardous Materials / **Chemical Spill**

- If the spill is life or health-threatening or you are unsure, evacuate the area immediately. If necessary, pull the fire alarm and evacuate the building.
- For major spills, call 9-1-1 immediately.
- All chemical spills, no matter how small, should be reported to Risk Management.

Fire / Explosion

Rescue yourself; followed by others if it is safe to do.

Alert others by activating the fire alarm.

Close the door on the way out.

Evacuate. Do not delay your evacuation to retrieve any materials, personal possessions, etc.



Utility Emergency

- Try to remain calm.
- Do not use elevators.
