In Memoriam



Frank R. Barreca, **KUAT Channel 6's first General Manager**, passed away peacefully in his sleep with a smile on his face the morning of September 26, 2023.

Frank was born to Jennie and Christopher on December 20, 1925, in Pittsfield, MA. He enlisted in the US Navy at age 17, training and flying as a pilot in WWII. The impact and intensity of Frank's service compelled him to join the naval reserves acting as LCDR until retirement in 1985.

He returned to the University of Arizona after active duty ultimately becoming an associate Professor creating and leading the Department of Radio and Broadcasting. His love for public broadcasting blossomed from Director at KVOA Radio and News TV to General Manager of KUAT-TV Channel 6. He received a National Award for Development from the Cooperation of Public Broadcasting.
